 - Not acknowledging the depth of it; seeing it as a costume or decoration instead of something spiritual for people

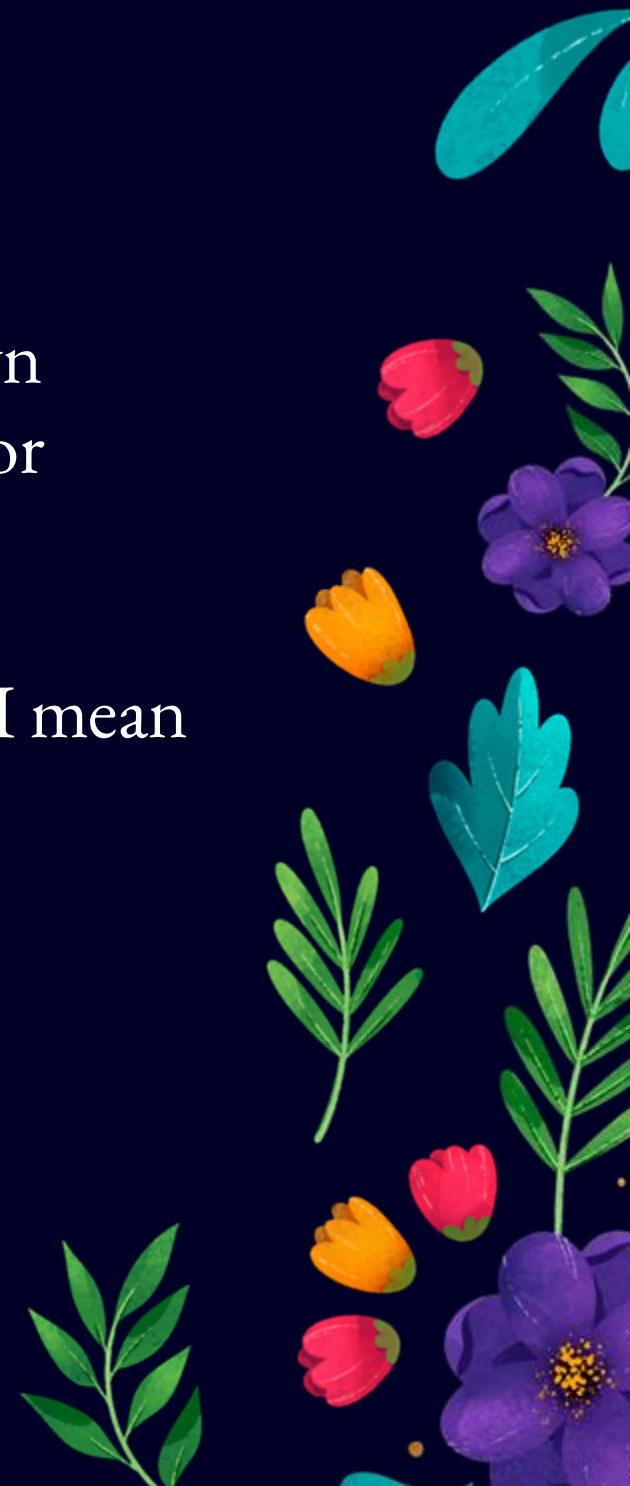

The Feast of All Saints

- Celebrated on Nov. 1
- Commemorates all saints, known and unknown
 - What does it mean for a saint to be known or unknown?
 - Are all saints famous people?
- “for the saints of God are just folk like me and I mean to be one, too”



Is the Feast of All Saints the same thing as Día de los Muertos?

- No. Día de los Muertos is specific to Mexico and Hispanic / Latino communities.
- The Feast of All Saints honors people who have died but not in exactly the same way.
